

**EDINBURGH UNIVERSITY CURLING CLUB  
BLUES CONSTITUTION**

**1. MINIMUM STANDARDS REQUIRED FOR BLUE**

A club member shall be eligible for nomination for the award of a Blue if that member satisfies the following criteria:

**1.1** That member has played in at least 75% of the club's first team fixtures over the previous two seasons, except in exceptional circumstances.

**1.1.1** First team fixtures shall be defined as fixtures played in the Scottish Universities Curling League and in the Universities Open Championship.

**1.2** The member shall be available to play for the club, if selected, before any other club.

**1.3** The member has been a part of the winning rink in either the Scottish Universities Curling League or the Universities Open Championship.

**1.4** The member has, while at university, placed in the top 20% in any of the following competitions:

**1.4.1** The Scottish Men's Championship

**1.4.2** The Scottish Ladies' Championship

**1.4.3** The Scottish Junior Championship

**1.4.4** The Scottish Mixed Championship

**1.4.5** The Scottish Pairs Championship

**1.4.6** The Scottish Mixed Doubles Championship

**1.4.7** The Scottish Wheelchair Championship

**1.4.8** The National Pairs Wheelchair Championship

**OR**

The member has placed in the top 20% in any competition analogous to those specified which is governed by any governing body recognised by the World Curling Federation other than the Royal Caledonian Curling Club

## **2. MINIMUM STANDARDS REQUIRED FOR HALF-BLUE**

A club member shall be eligible for nomination for the award of a Half-Blue if that member satisfies the following criteria:

- 2.1** That member has played in at least 75% of the first team fixtures over the last two years.
  - 2.1.1** First team fixtures shall be defined as fixtures played in the Scottish Universities Curling League and in the Universities Open Championship.
- 2.2** The member shall be available to play for the club, if selected, before any other club.
- 2.3** The member has been a part of the winning rink in either the Scottish Universities Curling League or the Universities Open Championship.

**OR**

The member has, while at university, placed in the top 20% in any of the following competitions:

- 2.3.1** The Scottish Men's Championship
- 2.3.2** The Scottish Ladies' Championship
- 2.3.3** The Scottish Junior Championship
- 2.3.4** The Scottish Mixed Championship
- 2.3.5** The Scottish Pairs Championship
- 2.3.6** The Scottish Mixed Doubles Championship
- 2.3.7** The Scottish Wheelchair Championship
- 2.3.8** The National Pairs Wheelchair Championship

**OR**

The member has placed in the top 20% in any competition analogous to those specified which is governed by any governing body recognised by the World Curling Federation other than the Royal Caledonian Curling Club
